Rates of Abuse and Neglect
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CLS Child Maltreatment Overview: The Chicago Longitudinal Study (CLS) has collected data on official records of child abuse and neglect from two administrative sources maintained at the Chapin Hall Center for Children: petitions to Cook County Juvenile Court and referrals to the Child Protection Division of Illinois Dept. of Child Services (DCFS). The abuse and neglect sample ( $\mathrm{N}=1411$ ) includes participants who resided in the Chicago area in 1990 ( $\geq$ age 10) or later.

Indicators: Tables 1a, 1b, and 1c present unadjusted descriptive statistics for rates of indicated (substantiated) abuse and neglect from DCFS, Court, and combined (DCFS \& Court) records, respectively. Overall, $10.3 \%$ of the sample had an indicated DCFS report, $8.2 \%$ had an indicated petition from juvenile court records, and $13.5 \%$ had an indicated report in at least one of the two administrative sources. No significant differences in rates of aggregate maltreatment by gender were detected across the sources. Females were more likely to have an indicated report of sexual abuse; no gender differences were found for other maltreatment subtypes. CPC preschool participation was associated with a significant reduction in substantiated maltreatment from age 4 through 17 for all data sources. CPC school-age participation was not associated with a reduction in indicated DCFS or Juvenile Court maltreatment records, but it was associated with a reduction in substantiated maltreatment in the combined measure. CPC participation was associated with a significant reduction in neglect from age 417 for all sources, and with a significant reduction in physical abuse in DCFS records.

Correlates: Table 2 lists correlations between select explanatory variables and indicated child abuse and neglect. A cumulative risk index (age $0-3$ ) was significantly correlated with maltreatment from age 4 through 17 across all data sources. Among the individual and family risk indicators measured prior to program participation, single-parent family status, having a mother who was a teen parent (< age 18), having a mother who did not graduate from high school, and family AFDC receipt were the strongest correlates. Interestingly, having four or more children was negatively correlated with all maltreatment indicators. This may reflect that, at the point of measurement (age 0-3), larger families were more likely to be headed by older parents, who may be less likely to abuse and/or neglect their children.

Subgroup Comparisons: Tables 3a, 3b, and 3c show the mean rates of maltreatment as they vary by certain background characteristics measured prior to CPC program participation. Significant unadjusted differences were evident for several individual-level variables, including scores on a composite measure of socio-emotional functioning from grades 1 through 6 (SEMAT16D), ITBS reading scores in grades 6 and 8 , school mobility ( $\geq 3$ moves, years $4-8$ ), and school retention ( $\geq 1$ grade). In addition, a number of family-level indicators were associated with increased rates of maltreatment, including single-parent family status, having a mother who did not complete high school, having a mother who was a teen parent (< age 18), AFDC receipt, previous child welfare service history, and having four or more risks on a composite risk measure.

Comparisons to Selected Samples: Figure 1 reveals that the incidence rate in Illinois for substantiated maltreatment in 1998 was comparable to the overall national rate. It also indicates that the rate for African American children was nearly double that of Hispanic/Latino children and nearly 2.5 times greater than Caucasian children. Figure 2 shows estimates of lifetime prevalence of maltreatment obtained from a recent meta-analysis conducted by Aos et al. (2004), which compared rates across 10 recent studies using weighted averages to correct for differences in definitions, populations, and times. The authors also estimate the prevalence rate for Washington State (See Figure 2). As expected, given the disadvantaged nature of our sample, the prevalence rate for the CLS is slightly higher than both estimates reported by Aos and colleagues.
